
This will be our last social event before we welcome our Plestin twins in April and will give everyone a chance to catch up on all the news.

It's because of the sheer volume of behind-the scenes work and the fact that venues require advance warning that we need to twinners return their booking forms asap and certainly by 20 March.

The booking forms are attached to the email with this edition of The Packet and they contain detailed information about costs and timings.

Itinerary for the twinning weekend

FRIDAY, 17 APRIL

Our Plestin twins are scheduled to arrive in Plymouth on board the Armorique at 9.30pm, so we expect them to be dropped off at **Launceston College car park about 11pm.**

SATURDAY, 18 APRIL.

This year, we have been really spoilt for choice of destinations with two historic houses or an attraction that appeals to young people on offer.

Coaches will be available for two venues (although twinners can use their own transport if they prefer). Coach seats will be allocated on a first-come, first-served basis and twinners will be charged for their seats, but not our Plestin twins.

Whichever destination is chosen, our twinning association will pay the entrance fees for all our French guests. Group entrance fees have been negotiated – so it is essential that all twinners using their own transport meet up with the main group at the time given in the booking form.

All venues have restaurants/cafes or outside areas for picnics.

Hidden Valley Discovery Park, Tredidon, St Thomas, Launceston, Cornwall, PL15 8SJ (*Twinners going to Hidden Valley to use their own transport - to arrive by 11.30am.*) Hidden Valley is full of puzzles, mystery, missions and secrets all waiting to be discovered.

Trelissick, Feock, near Truro, TR3 6QL, Cornwall

(Twinning coach available for this trip – departs Launceston College at 9.45am)

This welcoming National Trust country house and garden is set in an estate with stunning maritime views and lovely woodland walks. Visitors can explore the meandering paths through the garden, woodland walks and open parkland with views down the estuary to the town of Falmouth.

Killerton, Broadclyst, Exeter, EX5 3LE, Devon

(Twinning coach available for this trip – departs Launceston College at 10.15am)
Killerton Estate in the heart of Devon and boasts a friendly Georgian house set in working farmland, woods, parkland, cottages and orchards. There's plenty of calm space in the glorious garden and visitors can explore winding paths, climb an extinct volcano, discover an Iron Age hill fort and take in distant views towards Dartmoor.

SUNDAY, 19 APRIL

This will be a day with host families and then our big celebration party in the evening at Trethorne Leisure Centre.

Arrival will 6pm for 6.30 and there will be seating plans so that twinners and their guests will be together. Launceston band Feedback will provide the entertainment between 9 and 11pm from a range of music spanning the last five decades. For those who prefer a more tranquil setting to chat, there will be a quiet room.

The costs are £17.50 per adult and £8.75 per child and, of course, our French guests go free. All details are on the booking form attached to the email and you can let us know if you require vegetarian or vegan meals on the form.

Our visitors will return to France today and details of departure point and timings will be in the next Packet.
