THE STUDENT AND MR HENRI is a moving and cheerful 2015 French comedy-drama written and directed by Ivan Calbérac and based on his 2012 play of the same name.

An elderly curmudgeon lets out a room in his large apartment rent-free to a young student under one condition: she must do everything in her power to ruin his son's wedding.

The film brings together the real struggles of relocating to Paris as a student and a rare inter-generational friendship, weaving a tender story of both hilarious and tear-jerking moments.

- Carbonade of beef (pieces of beef cooked slowly with onions in real ale and served with new potatoes and carrots)
- Seville minted chicken
- Roasted butternut squash and spinach lasagne with green salad and garlic bread
